- <u>Before investing</u>, request free background checks (CRD Reports) on investment professionals registered with OFI.
- Ask about exemptions to registration with OFI, or suspicious investments.
- Report investment fraud for a confidential investigation.
- Request a <u>free</u> speaker for your group or conference in Louisiana on the red flags of investment scams.

Getting Started

When in crisis, we are especially vulnerable to poor financial decision making and fraud. If faced with job loss, divorce or separation, illness, or death in the family, never rush into an emotional financial decision. Take the time to ask yourself and your loved ones the questions below to help navigate life's storms.

Budgeting

- Do you have an accurate picture of your changed financial situation (i.e. income, assets, expenses and bills)?
- Where can you cut expenses to adjust for a loss of income or unexpected expense?
- Do you have someone you can trust to help manage your finances, if needed?
- What are your options for financial assistance (i.e. unemployment insurance, death benefits, divorce settlement)?

Saving

- Do you know all commissions, penalties, taxes and fees for withdrawing from savings or rolling over retirement funds?
- Can you develop a savings plan to restore funds you used in this crisis and build a new emergency fund?
