What's the Difference Between Using A Broker-Dealer/Stockbroker OR An Investment Adviser/Investment Adviser Representative?



Brokers or Broker/Dealers

(The company)

Stockbrokers

(Securities Salespersons)

Investment Advisers (IA)

(Either a person or business)

Investment Adviser Representatives

(Person giving advice on behalf of IA to other people, through meetings or communications

- Sells stocks, bonds and other investment products
- Paid on commission
- Legal standard Recommend investments that are <u>suitable</u> to meet the Client's needs and risk profile
- Where they must register
 - FINRA Financial Industry Regulatory Authority
 - 2. SEC Securities and Exchange Commission
 - 3. OFI Office of Financial Institutions

- Sells advice about investments, financial planning, investment strategy
- > Fee-based
- Legal standard Recommend only investments that are in the <u>best</u> interest of the Client, often referred to as Fiduciary Duty
- Where they must register
 - If they manage \$100M or more Assets Under Management (AUM)
 - a. Register with SEC
 - b. Notice-File with OFI
 - 2. If manage less than \$100M Assets Under Management (AUM)
 - a. Register with OFI
